### **Portsmouth Fort Gin £6.50**

<b>Prosecco Borgo Del Col Alto, Italy</b>	£8.00	£38.00
<i>Bouquet with fruity notes of peach, green apples and scents of acaia &amp; lilac. Fresh &amp; light palate.</i>		
<b>Chapel Down Bacchus &amp; Chardonnay A Touch of Sparkling, England</b>	£8.50	£42.00
<i>Made in the same way as the Borgo prosecco (tank method), a prosecco styled English sparkling wine. Characterised by aromas of pineapple, grapefruit &amp; elderflower. Gentle effervescence carries the tropical fruit &amp; floral flavours giving a crisp refreshing finish.</i>		
<b>Chapel Down Brut N.V, England</b>	-	£65.00
<i>Fermented in stainless steel followed by partial malolactic fermentation, wine is then left on fine lees within tank for 6 months before bottling. Then aged for a further 18 months on lees in the bottle to give rich complexity. Elegant English sparkling wine with aromas of red apple, lemongrass &amp; freshly baked bread together with hints of strawberry &amp; quince on the palate &amp; fine persistent bubbles.</i>

<i>Fresh, fruity, pale &amp; delicate lemon green in appearance. Aromas of lemons, apples &amp; white blossom on the nose. Palate is full of citrus, pear and melon.</i>			
<b>Whale Point, Sauvignon Blanc, South Africa</b>	<b>£6.00</b>	<b>£8.00</b>	<b>£32.00</b>
<i>Detailed legs/tears, bright, clear and green grassy. Pale lemon in colour with a very fresh nose of gooseberry, cut grass &amp; lemon. Palate has vibrant aromatics of zesty lemon, white flowers &amp; nettle.</i>			
<b>El Zafario Chardonnay, Spain</b>	<b>£6.50</b>	<b>£8.50</b>	<b>£34.00</b>
<i>A very good aperitif, Pardina grape ONLY grown in Spain, has a white stone peach character. Crisp green herb and floral aromas on the nose, white fruits such as apple and peach on the palate, balanced by a zesty citrus acidity crisp finish.</i>			
<b>Turning Heads Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand</b>	<b>£7.00</b>	<b>£9.00</b>	<b>£38.00</b>
<i>Lovely to enjoy on its own. More impact than the whale point, hints of kiwi, grapefruit flavour. Pale straw in colour, bouquet of ripe gooseberries, herb &amp; nettle and classic tropical fruit. Selective parcel of fruit blended to create an expressive dry that exhibits tropical flavours of pineapple &amp; lime.</i>			
<b>Chapel Down Bacchus, England</b>	<b>£7.50</b>	<b>£9.50</b>	<b>£42.00</b>
<i>One of three English grape varieties, designed specifically for the English climate, hints of unripe mango, elderflower &amp; lemon citrus. A crisp refreshing highly aromatic white, characterised by gooseberry &amp; elderflower on the nose. Palate is fresh &amp; zesty with flavours of nettle, kiwi &amp; freshly cut grass leading to a crisp dry finish.</i>			
<b>Domaine du Prieure, France</b>	-	-	<b>£45.00</b>
<i>A fine accompaniment to seafood or on its own as an aperitif. Made with 100% Aligoté grape, won't find this anywhere else in the world other than Burgundy, it's a wine lovers grape, fresh and long length, same profile as a Sauvignon Blanc. Fresh and easy drinking white, good balance and lively acidity.</i>

<i>Deep purple in colour with intense aromas of blackberries and cherries with rich, robust characteristics that are typical of the region.</i>

<i>Shipped from South Africa and bottled in UK. Round and supple, full of juicy plums, cherries &amp; blackberries. Complemented by a fresh acidity &amp; soft tannins.</i>			
<b>Tunante Tempranillo Rioja, Spain</b>	£6.50	£8.50	£34.00
<i>This plummy, soft seductive wine exhibits typical Tempranillo character of red fruits such as cherry, raspberry and plum with notes of liquorice and finishes soft and rounded.</i>

<i>Bramble fruits and black cherries on the nose, palate has great intense dark fruits such as cherries, plums and blackberry jam, in addition to rich notes of chocolate on the finish.</i>

<i>Smooth on the palate with lush flavours of redcurrants, plums, cherries &amp; slight earthy notes. Well-structured with supple tannins and a core of minerality.</i>			

## ROSE WINE

<i>The palate is full of soft, red fruit flavours which linger on the tongue.</i>			
<b>La Loupe Carignan Rose, France</b>	£6.75	£8.50	£35.00
<i>Drinks beautifully as an aperitif, is a Provence South of France style, More intense longer flavour to get you into 4th gear. Easy drinking and very fresh. Delightful expression of fresh red summer fruits, intense bouquet of wild strawberry, red current &amp; raspberry along with a lovely floral note of lilac, violet &amp; primrose. Palate is fruity and fresh with notes of garrigue, mint and pepper.</i>
